On Wednesday September 11th, the City Council will hold a public hearing that is generally focused on the proposed land use map and changes in land designations. During this hearing the City Council will also receive input on the Draft EIR. All substantive comments received on the Draft EIR during the public review period will be responded to in the Final EIR, and all comments will be considered in the decision-making process. No final decision will be made in the Draft EIR regarding going forward with the Land Use Element until after completion of the CEQA decision-making process.
